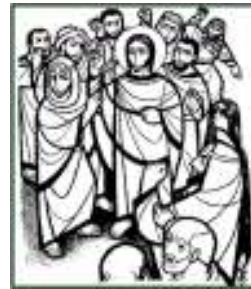

A Reading from S. Paul’s first letter to the

*1 Corinthians 13:4-13*

Love is always patient and kind; it is never  
jealous; love is never boastful or conceited;  
it is never rude or selfish; it does not take  
offence, and is not resentful.

Love takes no pleasure in other people’s  
sins but delights in the truth; it is always  
ready to excuse, to trust, to hope, and to  
endure whatever comes.

Love does not come to an end. But if  
there are gifts of prophecy, the time will  
come when they must fail; or the gift of  
languages, it will not continue for ever;  
and knowledge – for this, too, the time

will come when it must fail. For our
