The Liturgy of the Word

We sit for The First Reading

A reading from the Acts of the Apostles
Acts 15:1-2,22-29

Some men came down from Judaea and
taught the brothers, 'Unless you have
yourselves circumcised in the tradition of
Moses you cannot be saved.' This led to
disagreement, and after Paul and Barna-
bas had had a long argument with these
men it was arranged that Paul and Barna-
bas and others of the church should go
up to Jerusalem and discuss the problem
with the apostles and elders.

Then the apostles and elders decided to
choose delegates to send to Antioch with
Paul and Barnabas; the whole church
concurred with this. They chose Judas
known as Barsabbas and Silas, both
leading men in the brotherhood, and gave

*“Rejoice always, pray constantly, give
thanks in all circumstances for this is the
will of God in Christ Jesus for you”
1 Thessalonians Ch5 vv17-18.*

In this leaflet it is hoped that, as a parish, we will find
some direction and focus for our prayers that through
praying together for the same things and the same
people we may find a common purpose in responding
to the needs of our world and our parish and place
ourselves more readily into the hands of God.

A Reading from the book of the Apocalypse
