THE MASS

When the bell rings we stand:

The Introductory sentence:

In your strength, O Lord, the king rejoices; how greatly your salvation makes him glad! You have granted him his soul's desire, alleluia.

Priest: ✠In the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

People: **Amen.**

The Mass is introduced and we call to mind our sins.

Penitential Act

Priest: Brothers and sisters, let us acknowledge our sins, and so prepare ourselves to celebrate the sacred mysteries.

People: **I confess to almighty God

that I have greatly sinned,
in my thoughts and in my words,
in what I have done and in what
I have failed to do,**

And, striking their breast, they say:

**through my fault, through my fault,
through my most grievous fault;
therefore I ask blessed Mary ever-
Virgin, all the Angels and Saints,
and you, my brothers and sisters,
to pray for me to the Lord our God.**

everlasting life.

People: **Amen.**

Long live our noble King,

Long to reign over us:

Leader: For this United Kingdom, for His Majesty's other Realms and Territories, for the whole Commonwealth of Nations, for their governments and ministers, and for all who are called to public service, that they will seek justice, mercy, and peace:
Lord, in your mercy

People: **hear our prayer.**

Leader: For the peace of the world, for the welfare of all people, for those who care for others and for the environment, and for all in need:
Lord, in your mercy

People: **hear our prayer.**

Priest: Almighty God, the fountain of all goodness, bless our Sovereign Lord, King Charles, and all who are in authority under him; that they may order all things in wisdom and equity, righteousness and peace, to the honour of your name, and the good of your Church and people; through Jesus Christ our Lord.

People: **Amen.**

The Altar is prepared, then:
